WALKER AREA COMMUNITY FOUNDATION

The year 2015 marks our 20th year as a Community Foundation. Twenty years of gathering people, funds, and organizations together; twenty years of growing through prudent management and collaborations with other agencies; and, twenty years of grantmaking to respond to the most pressing needs of our community.

Following a suggestion from John T. Oliver, Jr., in 1995, Pat Willingham and the Community Health Systems Board set aside \$6 million in proceeds from the sale of the Walker Regional Medical Center to begin the endowment for the Walker Area Community Foundation. This donation has served as the principle for funding worthy causes that might otherwise be overlooked.

Other leaders involved in forming the foundation were the late J. George Mitnick and Larry Drummond. Together, Oliver, Willingham, Mitnick, and Drummond created a foundation that serves as a cornerstone on which solutions to our community's greatest problems are built.

Due to the wise investments made by the investment managers, the purchase and renovation of the Bankhead House & Heritage Center, and the faithfulness of our donors, the Community Foundation has been able to grow from its original \$6 million to more than \$23 million in assets.

THE COMMUNITY FUND

The Community Fund, our only unrestricted fund, is an endowment that enables us to respond strategically to community issues as they arise. Based on our knowledge and research, the Community Fund supports a wide variety of subject areas and organizations through a competitive grants process and other special initiatives.

COMPONENT FUNDS

Donors who want to endow their passion and provide endless support to specific charitable causes may choose to establish a component fund.

Component funds allow an advisory committee to focus on the charitable needs, and leave the administrative tasks to the Foundation. These funds are a permanent source of community capital, which will help the Foundation continue its work today, and far into the future.

Behind each fund is an abundance of success stories, so many that we couldn't possibly fit all of them on one page. You can see, however, that there are family funds and organizational funds. Each one holds its own purpose and history, but gains strength from being managed together. Donations can be made to any fund at any time.

BANKHEAD FUND was started by Walter Will Bankhead and has a long history of providing general philanthropic dollars for our nonprofits.

BARBARA DRUMMOND THORNE FUND, given by her estate, offers financial aid to the organizations that were closest to her heart.

DRUMMOND COMPANY, INC. (DCI) FUND provides aid first to present and then to retired employees of Drummond Company who suffered damage because of the April 27, 2011 tornados.

DTS FUND works to improve the quality of life and addresses the immediate needs in Cordova.

EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION FUND supports the Jasper City School system and its teachers with expenses not included in the general budget.

FAYE AND LEWIS MANDERSON FUND seeks to affect positive change and growth in Cordova through advancing and improving structures, as well as providing programs that will benefit residents.

FRIENDS OF CAMP O'REAR FUND supports the physical plant and surrounding environs of Camp O'Rear.

HEALTH ACTION PARTNERSHIP is a working group of Walker County health-related organizations striving to improve the health and lifestyles of our citizens.

JACKSON FAMILY FUND was founded with the belief that orphans and foster children should be afforded the privilege of attending programs like Camp McDowell. It will also provide educational enrichment experiences for children without parents and will support the ministry of the Episcopal Church of the same.

STRATEGY 1

CREATE ALIGNMENT AND A COMMON VISION

In our recently-conducted Strategic Planning process, we identified our initiatives through interviews, community conversations, and surveys. Many respondents agreed that leadership alignment and creating a common vision for Walker County are the critical pieces to moving Walker County toward a prosperous future.

The first strategic goal of the plan is to provide a framework of support to facilitate the building of strong, unified leadership,

and development of a county-wide common vision.

Walker Area Community Foundation facilitated this alignment through a series of Community Meetings hosted throughout the area. We welcomed all residents to share their thoughts and ideas to move the community toward the best future for everyone.

The plan is in its finishing stages and will be shared with each community.

READINESS

STRATEGY 2 STRENGTHEN EDUCATION

In order to promote quality of life and employment opportunities in Walker County, we must contribute to our strong education system. We reached consensus that our education efforts should focus on two distinct areas: Career Readiness and School Readiness.

Career Readiness focuses on initiatives, needs, and resources related to workforce development and career/technical training. Strong partnerships around career readiness are already in place in Walker County with an existing committee focused on career readiness that meets regularly. We believe a capable, motivated, and well-trained workforce will help build and attract a

strong industrial community. The Career Readiness Working Group has accomplished a great deal, and its continued success maintains momentum.

School Readiness focuses on programs, needs, and resources related to Pre-K education. We will reach out to educate parents about the importance of Pre-K education. We are continually seeking opportunities and resources to promote awareness of school readiness.

STRATEGY 3 SUPPORT NONPROFITS

One of the Foundation's primary objectives is to support the charitable needs and improve the quality of life of the people of Walker County and the surrounding area. This support occurs primarily through awarding competitive grants to individual nonprofits, serving as a partner in local nonprofit initiatives, helping build strong organizations, and connecting nonprofits with resources and with one another through the Nonprofit Council of Walker County.

We aim to continuously improve our methods and approaches through new technology, training, and insight that can help us become more effective.

The Foundation has created training sessions on issues such as board development, grant writing, volunteer recruitment, volunteer retention, good accounting practices, and encouraging a strong social media presence.

STRATEGY 4 PROMOTE HEALTHY LIFESTYLES AND RECREATION

Walker County ranks 65th out of 67 Alabama counties in regards to its citizens' health and well-being. Rates of infant mortality, child mortality, diabetes, and premature death are higher than the Alabama average. The Foundation is collaborating with the Walker County Health Action Partnership to turn these trends around.

To improve health outcomes, we are working to increase residents' access to fresh produce so that everyone can eat healthy. We're promoting active lifestyles by increasing opportunities for physical activity, and working to equip our area with safe places to walk, ride bicycles, or just play. Celebrating the natural resources of our area helps preserve them for future generations.

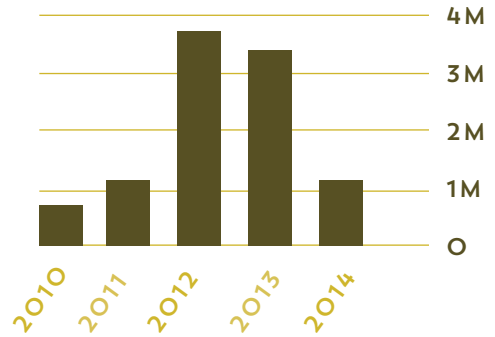

GRANTS GROWTH OVER TIME

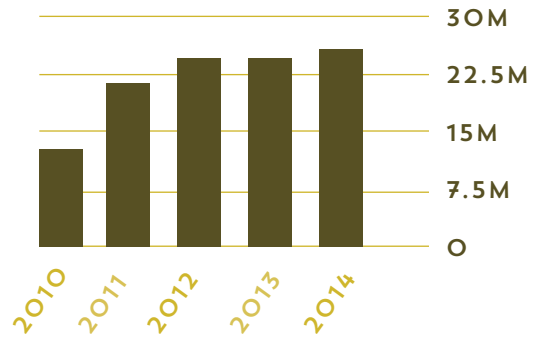
